1. It's church camp...**Bring a Bible!** (Preferably write your name in it.)
2. **Comfortable Shoes**....REALLY comfortable shoes; it's a steep hill and VERY rocky. (Flip-flops tend to, well, flop!)
3. **Bedding** for a twin sized bed.
 - a. Sleeping bags are usually best but sheets and blankets are perfectly fine as well. (Don't forget your pillow!)
4. All our cabins are air conditioned, so a **fan** is not really necessary, but you are welcomed to bring one to help stir the air a bit. (Don't forget the extension cord, if you do!)
5. **Clothing:**
 - a. Enough for 5 days (We don't want you to smell bad when you get home!)
 - b. Swim suit (see Dress Camp in Policies and Procedures!)
 - c. Laundry bag for dirty clothes (trash bag is fine, but laundry bag sounds better). This will keep your clean clothes from being 'contaminated' and keep your personal space in the cabin neater.
6. **Toiletries:**
 - Towel and washcloth(s) (No one wants to share theirs.)
 - Soap or body wash (please!)
 - Toothpaste and toothbrush (Those closest to you will thank you!)
 - Deodorant (again, PLEASE!)
7. **Sunscreen and bug spray** (It's camp!)
8. **Snacks or Money** for the Sugar Shack (The chefs in the Dining Hall will make sure you don't go hungry but buying a little treat is always fun.)

At the end of camp each year, we discover clothing, Bibles, and many other possessions that do not recognize their owners. Labeling the items your child brings to camp will help the cabin Counselors make sure the campers get back home with all (or at least most!) of their belongings!
