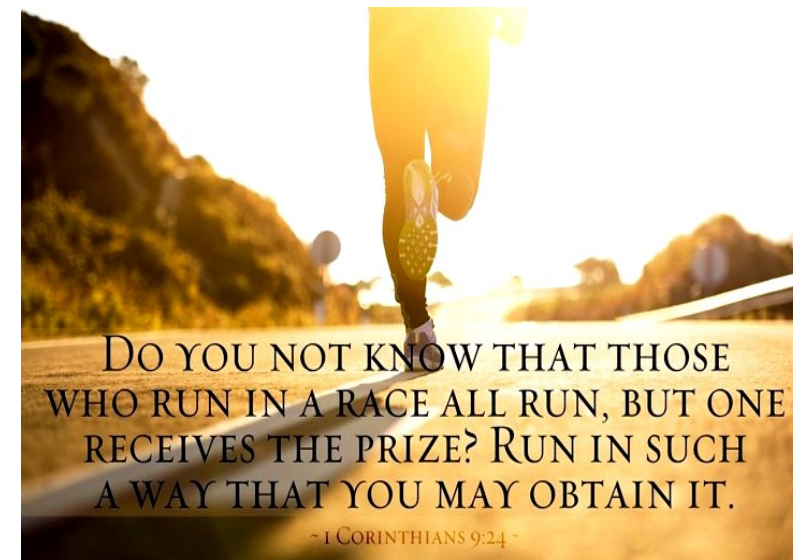

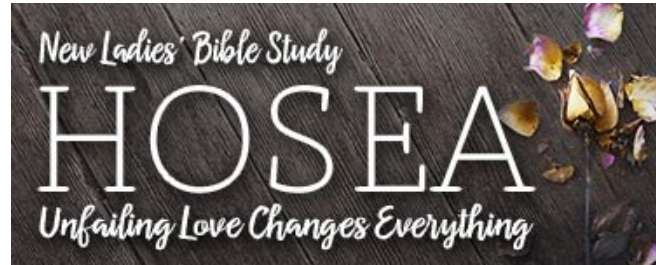

From the Pastor's Desk



G'day and Happy New Year,
 Beginning next week, I will kick off this year running in the pulpit with a message series from the Gospel of John titled, "Back to Basics". There is something fundamentally encouraging and edifying to follow one of the gospel accounts, especially through the Holy Spirit inspired lens of the apostle John. Besides containing some of the most well-known verses of Scripture, it documents the life of Jesus' ministry in detail, revealing that Jesus the Son of God is truly God in the flesh, the promised Messiah, and furthermore, the Savior of all mankind. Some have described this Gospel as the profoundest book in the world while many have pronounced it as the masterpiece of the Bible. Therefore, it is a wonderful body of God's Word to preach and to teach from over the coming months. Indeed, all the miracles Jesus did have one clear purpose – to lead people to believe that He is the Christ, the Son of the Living God and through Him alone we can be saved.
