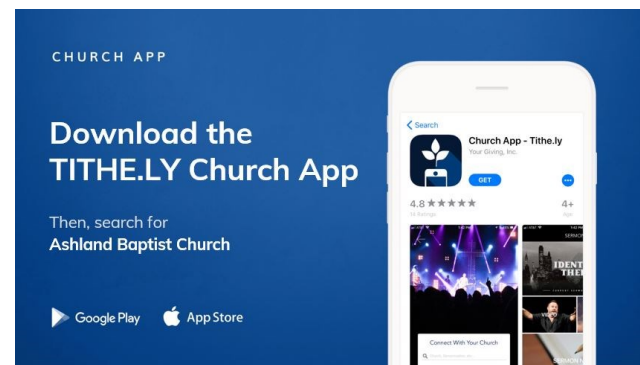
Operation Christmas Child ~
