Week of Prayer for IMB & Lottie Moon Christmas Offering

Southern Baptists observe a Week of Prayer, November 30 - December 7, for International Missions before the annual Lottie Moon Offering emphasis. Please join others to pray for missionaries around the world who are faithfully sharing the gospel.

Lottie Moon was sent as a Southern Baptist missionary to China from 1873 to 1912. She saw firsthand the world's greatest problem – **LOSTNESS**. Meeting so many people who had never heard the Gospel compelled her to write letters to American churches describing the need for a greater missionary presence. She pleaded for increased prayer and financial support to send and sustain more missionaries. This challenge became known as the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. Children flocked around her to try the sweet treats. Soon, mothers within the community invited Lottie into their homes where she told them about Jesus.
