April Vestry Reports Hannaford Gift Card

Michael Noone reported sales remain strong for the Hannaford gift card. Week to week figures are included with the church bulletin and have helped to close the deficit in the annual budget.

March Financial Report

The March financial report showed a cash deficit of \$639 for the month. Pledge income was 15.76% below budgeted and loose offering was

64.5% of budget. Fund raising returns were 11.78% over budget for the month. A projection for the year will be prepared for the May vestry meeting.

In addition over \$2600 was added to the church memorial fund in George Tregaskis' memory.

There was a discussion of the Diocesan Assessment during the meeting, and how it is calculated by the Diocese. The Standard Assessment is:

\$14,600 for the first \$100,000 of assessable income plus 20% of assessable income over \$100,000 That total is then reduced by 14.5% (multiply by 85.5%).
