Jack Fairbank is almost finished with the renovation of bathroom number three located upstairs near the kitchen. One more to do on the lower floor and that part of the update will be complete. Dedication of the bathrooms is scheduled for October 7 at the ten o'clock service.

Future Changes?

At the August vestry meeting three more projects were outlined by Jack Fairbank. He and Tom Green had obtained quotes for all three projects.

The first and least expensive of the three would be to install two lights, one on each side of the driveway near the parking lot. These would have block bases matching the sign and exterior walls. The lights would help with driveway visibility at night especially now that we are having more evening programs. Each base would cost \$1250 plus light and wiring. This proposal led to a discussion of other alternatives which would be less expensive including painting arrows on the lot to better highlight the driveway.

The second proposal would be to install the air-conditioning unit which was purchased 18 years ago for the two story office/kitchen wing. This unit was bought at the same time as the ones used in the main section of the building and has been stored since then. Since the furnace in that part of the building is 35 years old, it might be necessary to also replace the furnace as part of the project. This was tabled until the furnace needs to be replaced. Expected cost \$5500.

The third proposal was to replace the sliding doors on the north wall of the church with ones that would be more energy efficient. Simply replacing the doors would cost \$17,000. Since there is concern about the condition of the wall and the possibility of needing more of an upgrade or redesign, the vestry voted to consult Foresight Architects about this project.
