**Please Note the Following Important Changes**

- 1.** It is **extremely** important that we wear our name tags at all times, doing so will identify us to all church staff that we are supposed to be in the building!
- 2. Volunteers:** The only entrance to the building will be off 11th and Main. This is under the covered drive-through. There will be a buzzer just left of the covered drive-through entrance. Using the buzzer will alert staff to open the entrance for you.



## **THURSDAY, November 8th**

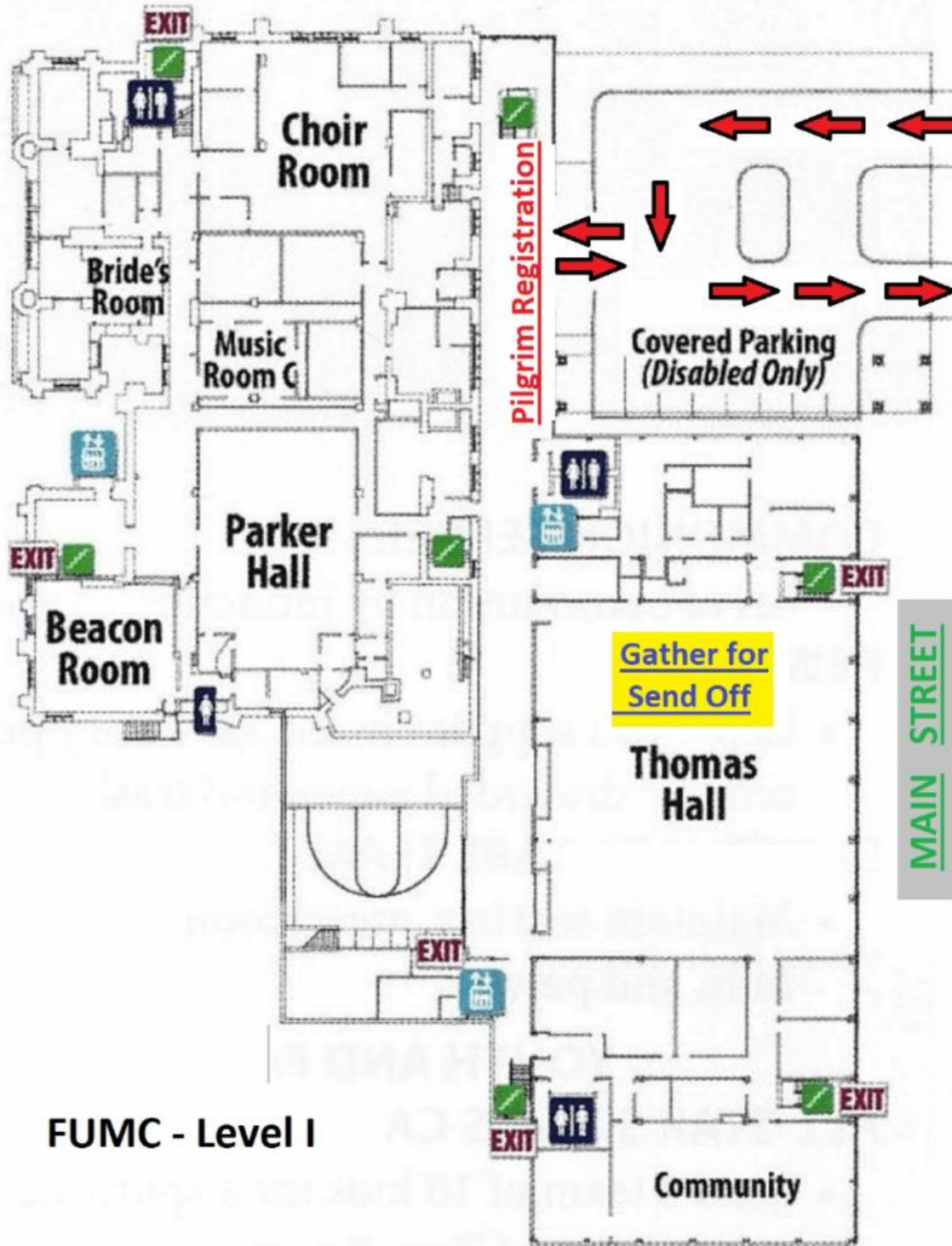
### **Preparation for send-off will begin at 4:00PM.**
