Psa. 1:1-6 Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly. Nor stands in the path of the sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his delight is in the Lord. And in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither.
