

THE NATIVITY OF OUR LORD

ALL THE WORLD WITH THE KEY TO HIS FREE GRACE

AS WE GATHER

When something is important, we attach a lofty word to it. So it is today. Christmas rejoices in the *incarnation*. That is of Latin origin, confessing that the Son of God is *in the flesh*. A chief mystery of the Christian faith, the eternal God takes on human flesh.

How can this be? St. Augustine marveled at the incarnation in which the Creator of all things enters His creation, in which He enters a womb that He had formed. It transcends our minds, for God transcends our minds.

Yet we confess the incarnation; we believe it; we rejoice in it for we receive unending blessings from it. God in human flesh brings all God's blessings to humans. Chief among them is His grace. John speaks of the incarnation, saying that the Word became flesh. And then he tells us the divine purpose for the incarnation. "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth" (John 1:14).

That gives words to our song:

There they found the wonder child, in lowly swaddling clothes lying, Yet all the world with His free grace supplying.

today I have begotten You"?



- P The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the first chapter.

¹ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him was not any thing made that was made. ⁴ In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

⁶ There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him. ⁸ He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.

SERMON All the World with The Key to His Free Grace

SECOND ARTICLE OF THE CREED (with explanation from Luther's Small Catechism)

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

- **P** What does this mean?
- I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death, that I may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.

PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

- Lord Jesus Christ, as our songs echo the song of Mary, so accept our thanks for all the faithful who have gone before us. Keep us steadfast in the true faith that we may join them in life everlasting by Your merit. God's own Son is born a child.

- P Heavenly Father, Your Son came in meekness to bear our weakness. So deliver all those who are sick and injured. If it be Your will, grant them healing in this life. Work amid their affliction to assure them of the full healing awaiting them in life everlasting. God's own Son is born a child,
- **C** God the Father is reconciled.
- Lord Jesus Christ, You are God ever reigning and have gained manhood through Mary. Grant us confidence that only You can make satisfaction for sin so that with boldness and confidence in You we may never falter. God's own Son is born a child.
- **G** God the Father is reconciled.
- P O Holy Spirit, in Christ the sheep are safe for He will indeed take care of them. As Christ feeds us with His own body and blood, work in us that we may receive this blessed meal in true faith. God's own Son is born a child,
- **C** God the Father is reconciled.
- P These our prayers we lift to You, O Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, for You live and reign, one God, now and forever.
- C Amen.


CANDLELIGHT CAROL OF HYMNS

P We hear again the Good News from the Gospel according to St. Luke, Chapter 2. Following each section of the reading, we sing Hymns of Christmas Joy, echoing the sound sof the angels on that first Christmas night.

In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be registered, each to his own town. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child.






HYMN "Gentle Mary Laid Her Child" (LSB 374)

P St. Luke writes that Mary "treasured up all these things in her heart." That phrase "all these things" includes her personal experience of that first Christmas night with the angels and the shepherds and the promise of God coming true. God has kept His covenant with his people, and we are blessed by it. With renewing faith, growing hope, and expanding love on this most holy night, let us sing possibly the most well known Christmas hymn; Silent Night.
