



And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate,


was crucified, died, and was buried.





Richard "Dick" Henk was born August 3, 1937 in Elgin, Illinois to Walter and Dorothy Henk. Dick was the second of five children – one older brother (Ron), two younger sisters (Judy and Janet) and a younger brother (Walt).

Dick was baptized, confirmed and grew in faith at Bethlehem Lutheran



Church in West Dundee, Illinois. He was married to Kathleen Kays on June 29, 1958 in Ottawa, Illinois. Dick passed to life everlasting on March 11, 2019.

Dick served in the United States Navy in Great Lakes (IL), Bethesda Naval Hospital (MD), and Guantanamo Naval Base (Cuba). He sang with the Chanteymen Naval Chorus, which traveled the U.S. for the Navy. Dick worked in retail, owning a paint, wallpaper and framing store for years. He also worked in real estate, working as a broker to own and operate, along with Kathy, their own real estate office in Zephyrhills, Florida.

Dick directed church choirs and handbells for over 30 years. He also sang in many barbershop quartets over the years. He truly had a love for harmony and music of many kinds. He was a lifelong member of various churches within the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, and a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Brooksville, Florida at his death.

Dick is survived by his wife of 60 years, Kathy, four children – David Henk (Ann) of Poland, Indiana, Linda Meseke (Paul) of Brooksville, Florida, Brian Henk (Sheenah) of Daleville, Alabama, and Wayne Henk (Lynette) of Babcock Ranch, Florida, eight grandchildren and two great grandchildren. He will be interred at Florida National Cemetery in Bushnell, Florida.
