Isn't that our situation time and again? Often our list of good intentions is longer than our list of good accomplishments! And how often our list of determined "no-no's" (those things we know we should not do) turns out to be our day's agenda!

As we participate in the human tragedy in the wake of sin, including breaking down, we are thankful that God still gives us the victory through Jesus Christ our Lord.

He still declares us righteous because of Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son. Even though we are sinners, God looks at us through Christ and all He sees are His children the saints. Now meditate on these words;
Jesus, Thy blood and righteousness
My beauty are, my glorious dress,
Wherein before my God I'll stand
When I shall reach the heavenly land.

Let us look to being in Scripture together more and more. Being forgiven, let's forgive more freely. Let us love as Christ first loved us and be the church that is a family. Uplifting each other, helping each other where we are able.

As we love like Christ, we will find ourselves closer to Christ each day, week, month, year, decade, and our lifetime. Let's live like the saints God knows us to be. Being the church that is a family, living loving and trusting in Christ and in each other as we live out the mission of Christ and salvation in our lives.

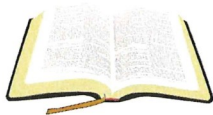

We are very grateful for the opportunity this summer to refresh and recharge, looking ahead to how God will continue to lead us in this ministry.

As the summer is officially behind us, we set out on our 19th year in Asia considering the challenges and opportunities that await us.

Lily and Olivia began their first full week back, though classes will maintain a hybrid manner as Korea deals with an uptick of Covid-19 cases. The girls were able, thankfully, to be on campus for two full days for a new student orientation as ambassadors for their respective classes (10th and 8th grades). More than school ambassadors, it is our prayer that they continue to serve as ambassadors of Christ in their classrooms and through their relationships at school, church, and our community.

One of the exciting happenings at our local congregation of International Lutheran Church is a full switch to live stream services. For many in the US, such a change may seem ordinary, but multiple factors contributed to the slow rollout of this adjustment. Regardless of the timeline, we were happy to be a part of designing this new, more efficient means of offering live worship opportunities via distance. This is also a huge blessing to our fellow missionary colleague, Pastor Carl, who continues to lead the flock in Korea and beyond. Additionally, we are improving on how we use other tech resources to make our presence known in this city of over 10 million people.



With no immediate plans to physically visit ministry sites in the region due to local travel restrictions, Matt is reenrolling in lessons to increase his language study. Previous schedules and work routines prevented such dedicated time to continued study and we are thankful for the availability of a Korean teacher to help further his proficiency. May God use this opportunity to open more doors for the Gospel to be shared with clarity.

With you, by God's grace, we are able to serve in this place. Thank you, our partners in ministry, for your continued love and support.
