Church Planting Center: John Vernon introduced the following to share reports:

John Vernon's CPC report focused on Church Plants, introducing Ednor Sebag who serves as our Filipino Church Planting Catalyst for the region, Enoc Baeza who serves as our Hispanic Church Planting Catalyst for the region, and a new Deaf Ministry that is being organized locally, and the

DOM Report: John Vernon introduced Amy Elfrink, member of FBC Oak Ridge working with the True Vine Christian Counseling group, who is working as a provisionally licensed counselor out of the associational office. Looking forward, he announced that Cape Baptist Association will be a training center for church planters through the North American Mission Board. Additionally, he informed the association he would be seeking to develop a new vision & mission for the association, including updates to the constitution and bylaws to bring them into alignment with the new vision & mission, over this next year.

Worship in Song: Trinity Baptist Women's Trio - Pattie Brooks, Amy Richardson, & Sharon Biehler sang "Jesus Saves."

Partnership Missions: Roger Graham shared the association has partnership missions with Belluno Italy, Alberta Province Canada, and Filipinos worldwide. The Filipino partnership encompasses all nine associations in the Southeast region of Missouri. Because of Covid there have not been any trips to Italy or Canada. There was a regional Acts 1:8 Conference at Miner Baptist Church this Spring of 2021 focusing on the Filipino Ministry and how it impacts our local, North American, and International work in partnership with our local association, NAMB and IMB.

Partnership Missions/Annual Sermon: Ed Carter, pastor at Trinity in St. Mary asked his wife, Joye, to read Acts 13: 1-6 and she led in prayer. Pastor Ed's message was focused around four points: 1)Seeking to Send, 2)Set a Precedence, 3)Suspect the Unexpected, 4)Solicit to Bring More to the Partnership.
