Hurricane Harvey, Tornadoes, and Hurricane Florence=CGBA Assistance

The Cape Girardeau Baptist Association's Chainsaw/Mud Out Unit has had 4 deployments this past year.

- October 14-21, 2017, they responded to Groves, TX to help with clean-up after Harvey.
- February 27-28, 2018, found the unit in Malden, MO following a tornado.
- June 11-15, 2018, the unit was in Forrest City, AR, doing clean-up work after a tornado/wind-related event.
- September 24-October 2, 2018, massive flooding following Hurricane Florence called for the assistance of the CBGA's mud-out, tear-out crew.

The Feeding Unit/SEMO Kitchen left the state on the morning of September 16, 2018 headed to North Carolina. Destination became Wallace, North Carolina. For the 11 days the kitchen operated, 54,100 meals were prepared. Of the 48 people from Missouri that responded, 6 from CGBA assisted in this operation.

All these responses were made possible because of the support---prayers, monetary, volunteering and leadership of CGBA people.
