**Greetings in Christ's most precious name!**


God's ministry among the Filipinos in Southeast Missouri started as early as the late quarter of 2015 when we, my wife, daughter and I drove about 4 hours from Springfield to meet Filipinos (with their American spouses and children) once a month in Doniphan/Poplar Bluff and Cape Girardeau for fellowship and Bible studies. Since then, after moving here in mid -2016 to fully concentrate on the ministry, we have steadily pursued regular fellowship and bible studies in these areas and by God's grace have added two more fellowships in Sikeston and Puxico. Six new believers in Christ were baptized in Sikeston and Jackson groups. We praise God for what He has accomplished through us and we are excited for what He will continue to do to reach Filipinos and even other ethnic groups for Jesus Christ. Your prayer and support contributed significantly to the growth of the Filipino ministry.

This coming December 30, 2018, we are planning on a big event to bring together our Doniphan/Poplar Bluff group, Sikeston group, Puxico group, Cape Girardeau/Jackson group extending invitation to those in the Farmington area and Puxico group for an inter-fellowship gathering: a post-Christmas and pre-New Year celebration. The event will be held at the Family Center of First Baptist Church of Sikeston. It will feature potluck dinner, a worship celebration through music featuring the talents coming from our four fellowship groups, which will be highlighted by a group caroling competition, christmas-related games for children and adults and most importantly presentation of the gospel message. Lord willing, we expect about 100 -120 people to attend as invited people from as far as Ellsinore to Pevely. We are so excited about holding this interfellowship as assembling us altogether will help strengthen the bond and their spiritual walk when they know that there are also Filipinos in these cities with they share a common fath in Jesus Christ. And most importantly, the gospel message will still be proclaimed and thus unsaved individuals in the gathering can still hear the gospel.
