

Things You Need To Know

What to Bring:

Bible	Towels/Washcloths
Pen/Pencil	Pillow
Bug Repellent	Sheets/Blanket/Sleeping Bag
Toothbrush/Paste	Clothing
Soap/Shampoo	
Modest Swimsuit (no two-piece for gals or speedos for guys)	

ATTENTION! Bring "play clothes". You will likely get messy!!

DO NOT BRING MONEY, CELL PHONES, or other valuables! **CAMPERS MAY NOT DRIVE THEIR OWN VEHICLES TO CAMP!**

Camp begins on Monday at 1:30pm. Registration begins at 1:00pm.

DO NOT ARRIVE early expecting to register or claim a cabin. There is also no supervision of children or teens prior to opening of registration.

Camp ends on Friday at Noon. Camp activities will commence up until that time. Picking campers up early means that they will miss out on a very important part of camp. Lunches will not be served on Monday or Friday.

1st & 2nd Grade Overnight Camp begins on Friday at 5:00pm. Camp ends on Saturday at 5:00pm. Remember that a responsible adult must accompany your child and fees must be paid for the adult also.

Please do not send your child to camp if:

- (1) he/she has been exposed to any contagious disease during the two weeks prior to camp,
- (2) he/she has head lice, ringworm, rash, or open sores at camp time, or
- (3) he/she would be unable to participate in the full camp program from Monday arrival through Friday departure.

NOTE: Any camper caught damaging camp property will be sent home immediately!! The camper's parent/guardian will be responsible to pick up the camper and pay for the damages.

Space is limited to the first 110 paid, registered campers.
