

# BMA of Oklahoma Outbreak

## Important Information

**Date:** December 27<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>

**Theme:** 3 Days, John 2:19

**Location:** Quartz Mountain Lodge in Altus, OK

### Checklist:

- Order shirts by **December 1<sup>st</sup>** by mailing or texting your church's order to Zach and mailing a completed pre-registration form to the address listed. Shirts are included in the registration fee paid upon arrival at Outbreak.
- Reserve rooms by **November 24<sup>th</sup>** by calling 580-563-2424 and telling them you are part of the Baptist Missionary Association of OK Outbreak.
  - Reservations must be guaranteed by a credit card or advance deposit.
  - Rooms are approximately \$69 per room per night.
- Cancel unneeded rooms by **December 25<sup>th</sup>**.
- Register at the Lodge upon arrival **December 27<sup>th</sup>**. Please provide a rooming list and tax exemption form.
- Register with Outbreak upon arrival by turning in a completed registration form, completed student cards, and a \$45 registration fee for each participant.

### Things to Note:

- On the way to the service project on Friday, students will stop and eat with their small group. At this time, each student will be responsible for purchasing their own meal. During the service project, there will be drinks and snacks provided by Outbreak.
- All meals, apart from Friday lunch (see above) will be the responsibility of each individual church. The restaurant at the lodge will be open should churches decide to dine there. Continental breakfast prices start at \$7.95 per person; full breakfast starts at \$10.95; lunch begins at \$11.95; and dinner begins at \$19.50. These prices do not include 18% service charge and sales tax.
- Outbreak activities are geared toward 6<sup>th</sup> grade and above. Participants younger than this will be the responsibility of their parents.
- Churches should obtain a liability release form for every participant. You may use the one included in this packet or another of your choosing. These forms will not be turned in but will be kept by each individual church. The health and safety of participants is the sole responsibility of the church sponsoring them. Although we do not anticipate any mishaps, each church will need written permission from a guardian in order for a medical facility to treat the participant.
