Our **Feeding the Hungry** program provides take-out meals to anyone who is hungry on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5 to 6:30 p.m. **PLEASE**, we need cooks and other volunteers. Contact **Laurel Hostler**.

Starting May 4, we will offer limited capacity indoor dining, in addition to take-out meals.

We need helpers and substitute teachers in our **Children's Sunday School** classes. *We need 2 adults in every children's classroom.* Teachers must be church members for at least 1 year. Food Pantry

Our **Food Pantry** distributes baskets on Thursdays, from 9 to 11:45 a.m. There are no income restrictions, but you must reside in Show Low, Linden, Pinedale, Clay Springs, White Mountain Lakes, or the “Y” area of Vernon. You are eligible for a full basket **once** per calendar month and can get bread and produce (when available) on other Thursdays. Bring a photo ID *every time* and verification of address (utility bill or government document) on your first visit.
