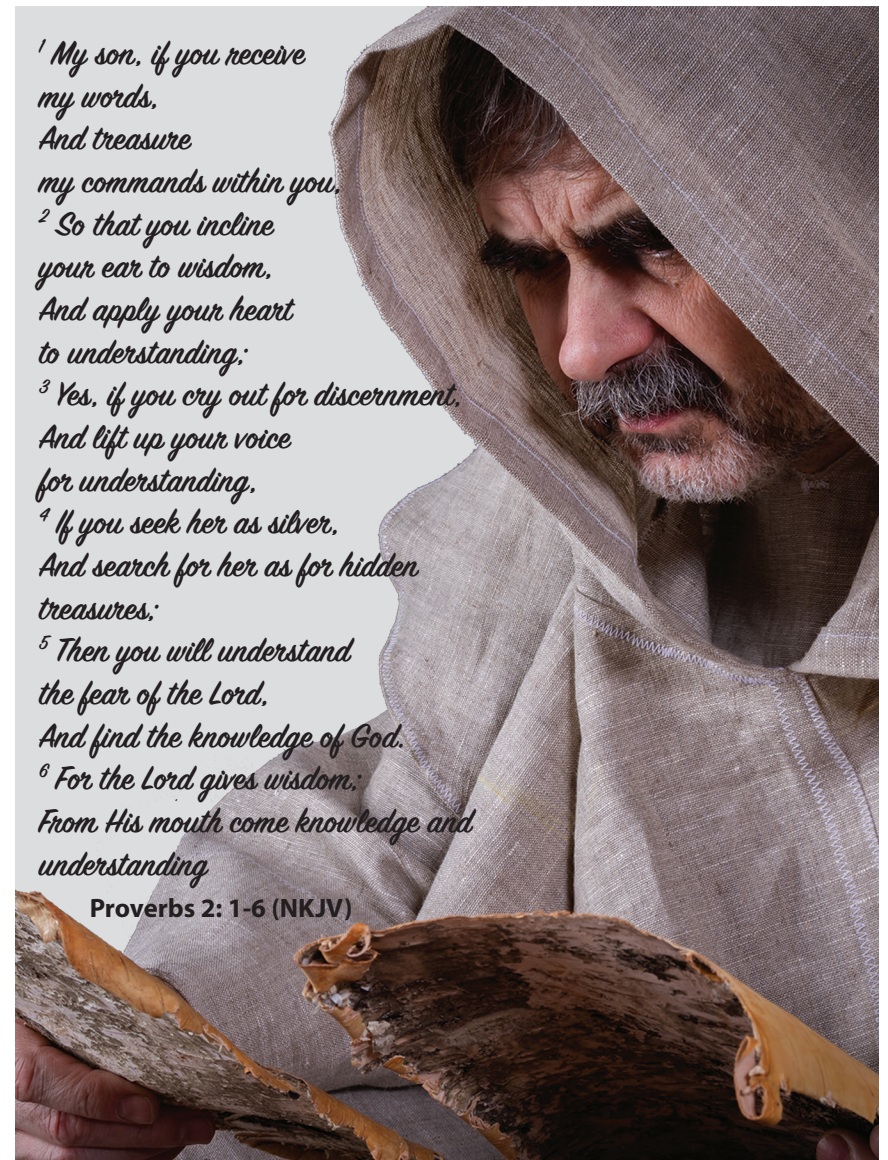

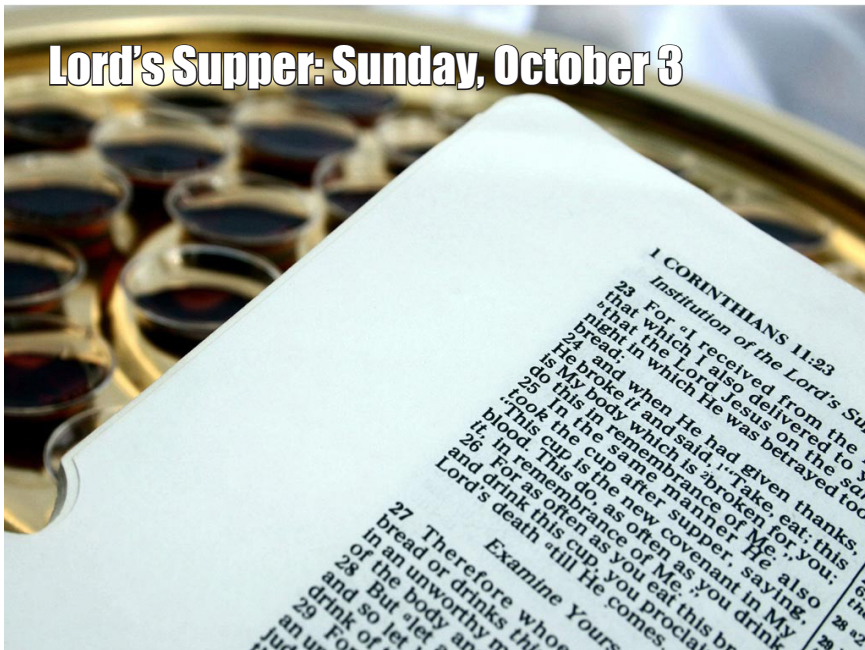

Feeding the Hungry Volunteers:



Our **Feeding the Hungry** program provides meals to anyone who is hungry on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5 to 6:30 p.m. We offer indoor dining or as take-out.

PLEASE, we need cooks and other volunteers. Contact **Laurel Hostler** or the office.

Food Pantry

Our **Food Pantry** distributes baskets on Thursdays, from 9 to 11:45 a.m. There are no income restrictions, but you must reside in Show Low, Linden, Pinedale, Clay Springs, White Mountain Lakes, or the "Y" area of Vernon. You are eligible for a full basket **once** per calendar month and can get bread and produce (when available) on other Thursdays. Bring a photo ID *every time* and verification of address (utility bill or government document) on your first visit.



Supplies Needed: We need single-size toiletries – toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, deodorant, combs, hairbrushes, disposable razors, shave cream, lotions, shampoo & conditioner, and feminine products. Just leave donations in the rear foyer. These hygiene packs are distributed during our Food Pantry ministry.



Service Opportunities:

Our nursery needs volunteers during the morning worship service. If you can help, please contact **Linda Milner** or the church office.

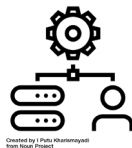

- Soccer ball (Make sure to include a manual air pump.)
- Stuffed animal
- An outfit of clothing to wear
- Small musical instrument (such as a harmonica or woodwind recorder)



CRAFTS & ACTIVITIES

- Pencils
- Small manual pencil sharpener
- Colored pencils
- Pencil case
- Crayons
- Markers
- Pens
- Coloring pads
- Coloring books
- Picture book
- Notebooks
- Glue stick (Do not include liquid glue.)
- Small adhesive tape
- Watercolor set
- [Finger paint palette/crayons/markers (non-liquid containers), paint brushes, canvas or paper]
- Make-it-yourself craft items or kit
- Playdough (Consider adding plastic cookie cutters as non-sharp utensils the child can use with the playdough.)
- Stickers
- Building blocks

- Interactive toys that include push buttons, lights, noise (include extra batteries)

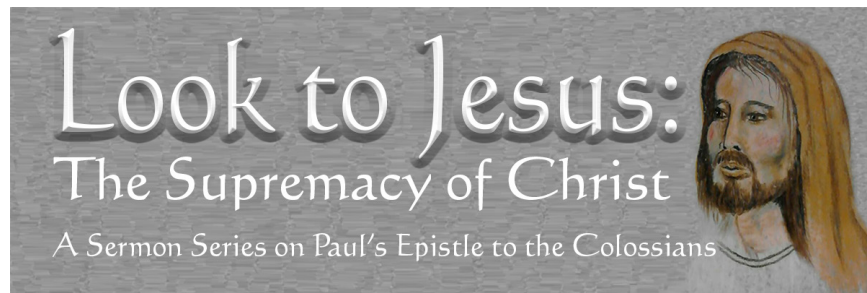
