

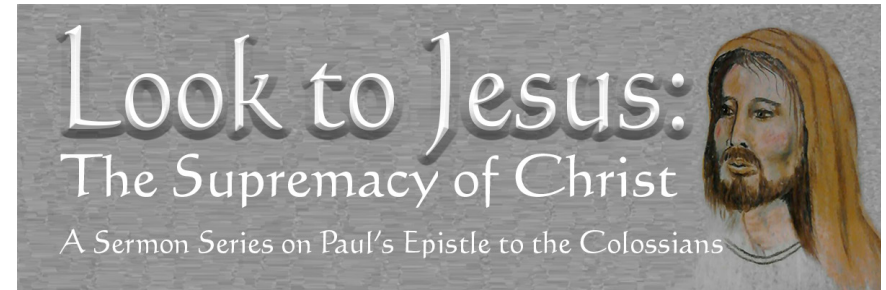

Bought with the precious blood of Christ.

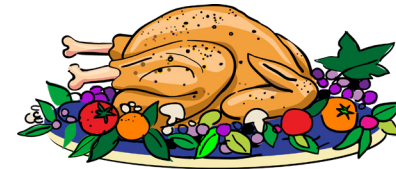
