Pastoral letter:

Dear Friends,

I am in the time of life where I speak quite a bit about language. “It is wrote, not write-ed...most past tense words end in “ed,” but not all of the.” “Why?” Good question! The best answer I’ve found is that the English language is comprised of many different languages, so plenty of differences exist in our language and exceptions to every rule exist. Perhaps you can name an exception to even that rule!

Diversity is one of the gifts of God at Pentecost. On that first Pentecost, people from all over the known world were gathered to celebrate in Jerusalem. Suddenly, the Holy Spirit rushed over the disciples, and everyone gathered was able to hear in their own language. 1 Corinthians 12 describes some of the gifts from the Holy Spirit: wisdom, knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, miracles, prophecy, discernment, speaking and understanding language. Verse 7 states, “To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.” The Spirit offers a variety of different gifts, all for the common good. Difference is wonderful!

Which gifts have you received? In what ways might we use our diverse gifts for the common good of God’s reign in the world?
