Rev. Dr. Orville B. Jones, Jr. is a native of Indianapolis, Indiana. Our pastor was led to Christ by his mother, Sister Sarah L. Jones, and was baptized under the pastorate of the Rev. Dr. C. Henry Bell of Mt. Paran Missionary Baptist Church in Indianapolis. He acknowledged his call to the ministry in August of 1976.

After college and a short time in the AME Church, Dr. Jones united with the Light of the World Christian Church under the leadership of the Rev. Dr. T. Garrott Benjamin Jr. He studied under the tutelage of Dr. Benjamin for 8 years.

Dr. Jones served the Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church in Indianapolis, under leadership of Rev. Alfred F. Barber where he was ordained to the gospel and became the Interim Pastor before moving to Illinois.
