

Colossians 3:17 (The Daily Life Bible)

As we live life, it is easy to forget who we are and whose we are. We very conveniently compartmentalize our lives. There is our Sunday self, our work self, and our home self. We conduct ourselves very differently in each of these situations. We even talk differently in these different situations. We say things at home that we would never say in front of people who are not part of our inner sanctum. We feel free to really express ourselves. I am not referring to inappropriate language, I am talking about what we call letting our hair down. Just telling it like it is. That is fine to a certain point; however, we should not do or say anything that dishonors Christ. Our words should be words of wisdom, words of truth, and words of righteousness. The
