Moses agreed...conditionally. IF they did as promised, THEN that land would truly be their gift from the Lord. BUT, if they did not do as they promised, their sin against the Lord would surely find them.

If you have ever paid attention to our Pastor's preaching of his early days in ministry you know that he, at times, was defiant. One can only image his father in the ministry being fearful (as Moses was) of any action against him the Lord would rain. With a spiritual ear attuned to these sermons, you know how the Lord has blessed our Pastor's spiritual growth and maturity in ministry. Yes, even in his pastoring.

With my spiritual eyes and ears I can bear witness to how one's obedience can bring about abundant favor from God. It has nothing to do with being a perfect man (or woman); but it has everything to do with *striving* for perfection, and showing oneself approved, and loving the Lord like one's eternal soul depended upon it...

It also does not hurt to remove the clods of negative behavior and negative thoughts to make our soil as welcoming as possible.

Every day there are opportunities for us to become "gardens". We can invite God and his message of love into our hearts. We can open ourselves to his purpose for our lives. Our fruit should be a blessing to others. The world should see our yield and want to partake of it. The fruit we bear should be beacons to draw others to God.

As I think ahead to the harvest, I am also looking into my own heart. Am I allowing God to plant seeds of love that can be a blessing to others? Would anyone want to partake of the yield from my garden? What am I planting and what am I harvesting?
