She was in no way prepared for what she saw. Her sister was (is) a shadow of her former self. Stage 4 cancer! Amazingly, her sister's attitude seemed to disregard the potential fatality of her situation.

The focus of the above is not the person sharing; or her story. The focus is the class. If you are under the impression that Bible Study is merely us sitting, taking notes (hopefully) while a teacher talks - you couldn't be more wrong! If you think you have nothing to learn or contribute...wrong again! Even our sharing sister was unaware that another woman in the class is going through something extremely similar with her own sister.

Bible study (and yes, Sunday School) offer wonderful opportunities that cannot be gained during worship services. We have amazing chances to impact the lives of our brothers and our sisters in Christ. We can share our struggles, our triumphs; we encourage and uplift; we sympathize and empathize. We get to know each other on a deeper level through our confessions and through our testimonies. We have a safe place to be open and transparent.

My prayers for this woman are now specific. She can no longer be lumped into the prayer for my church family. I pray for her and her family; for spiritual eyes to see beyond what natural eyes can see. I pray for the peace in her situation that only God can provide. In Jesus' Name...
