## **A Compelling Witness**

Jesus often shared parables with his listeners to make a point. A parable in the Bible is simply an earthly example with a heavenly meaning. In this parable Jesus tells of a man who prepared a grand feast. Many guests were invited, but one by one they made excuses for not being able to attend the special event. The man ordered his servants to go out and find guests, total strangers, to dine with his family. After giving out many invitations, there was still room for more. The father gave the order again, "Go out…and compel them to come in, so my house can be full!"


Do you ever wonder why churches have van and bus routes? In many places church members go out and knock on doors regularly to invite people to church. Does this seem like a waste of time, a useless endeavor? Not according to God's Word! This parable would suggest that it is important for God's house to be filled. The church, meaning the people, not the building, is commissioned to reach for the lost and bring them to Jesus.

How terrible it would be to have the cure for a terrible disease and selfishly keep it to yourself while others around you are dying. What a privilege it is to know Jesus, to experience the truth of His Word, to know the joy of having your sins washed away through baptism in His name, and being filled with the power of the Holy Ghost. The Bible reminds us, "To whom much is given, much is required," (Luke 12:48).

Who do you work with, go to school with, live near, or pass everyday? With a simple invitation from you, perhaps they would join you in God's house this week. Are you a compelling witness for Jesus?


