Researching one's ancestry seems to be quite the fad these days. More than a few people who have applied to one of the popular websites for DNA results have made some startling discoveries, often not exactly what one expected.

The Gospel of Matthew also recorded ancestral facts that may have been surprising to some people in that day. Although many took pride in being a descendent of the great King David, they may have failed to take into consideration that David's own great-grandmother was not the traditional Jewish young lady, raised in a kosher Israeli home. No, Ruth grew up in a Moabite nation, worshipping gods other than Jehovah. But then she met and married Mahlon, the son of Elimelech and Naomi, who brought her into the truth of the One True God worshipped by their Jewish ancestors.

When Mahlon died and left Ruth a widow, she had to make a decision. Would she turn back to the false gods worshipped by her people, or would she cling to the truth that she had come to know? On the fateful day in which her mother-in-law, Naomi decided to return to Israel, Ruth insisted on joining her. "...whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God:" (Ruth 1: 16). Ruth's declaration did not come from an unsure heart. Beyond a doubt, her heart was fixed on serving the God of Israel. Little did Ruth know that her decision would place her firmly in the lineage of King David, and eventually, Jesus, the Savior of the world.

Many people today may not be able to trace their lineage past one or two generations. Others may be able to go back farther than that, but may find that they are not very proud of the legacy that has been passed down to them because it is one of sin and abuse. But God doesn't judge us by the world's standards or by the reputations of our ancestors.

No matter our lineage or social standing in this world, God has given us something far greater than anything this world can offer. The Apostle James reminded us that we will live and reign in heaven with Jesus someday. "...my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him? (James 2: 5). We have a great heritage because we are chosen by God!
