God’s Way is Right

In Deuteronomy chapter 6, God instructed His people to take His commandments seriously. He had just brought them out of the land of Egypt where they had been slaves for 400 years. Now they were dwelling in the land that God had promised them. While they were no longer slaves, they were surrounded by nations who served and worshipped false gods. Through Moses, God reminded His people,

“Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God is one LORD.” Deut. 6:4

Moses went on to tell the people, “And these words which I command thee this day shall be in thine heart. And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children...” Deut. 6:6-7

God in his wisdom chose families as the number one structure to disciple his people. If our children are going to walk in the ways of the Lord and if we plan on accomplishing anything for the kingdom of God, it is simply not enough to rely on the Pastor and Sunday School teachers to carry the burden for instructing our children.


Training our families in the ways of the Lord is a full-time job, but it is necessary if we want to inherit the land and receive the blessings God has planned for His people!

“Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; A blessing if ye obey the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you this day, And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the Lord your God...” Deut.11:26-28a
