You're An Overcomer!

The great Apostle Paul penned the words of this verse from a prison cell. He wasn't put into prison for stealing or lying or even for hurting anyone. As a matter of fact he wasn't there because he did anything wrong. He was put into prison for preaching the truth of God's Word to people who didn't want to hear it.

Can you imagine that! And yet, his faith in God stood strong and unwavering. We never read where he ever questioned God about his circumstances. We never read where he regretted his decision to serve God or to preach the gospel. As a matter of fact, Paul considered himself a servant of Jesus Christ. A servant does whatever the master of the house wants him to do. And that is exactly what Paul did.

Sometimes you may feel lonely as a Christian when everyone around you is doing something you know you shouldn't participate in. But God will give you strength if you will trust Him. You may feel the pressure of temptation when the world tries to offer you things that are contrary to God's Word. But scripture tells us in 1 Corinthians 10:13,

"There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it".

The Apostle Paul wrote these words to the church at Corinth and he knew what he was talking about! Stay faithful to God, resist temptation, and you will be able to say, just like Paul, "There is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day..." (II Timothy 4:8).


