Fridays through Lent, the Brotherhood will lead Stations of the Cross. Feb 28 - Apr 3, 6pm.



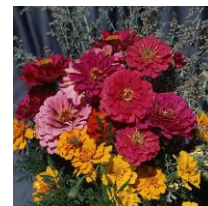
Coffee Hour
