The next quarter booklets, Aug-Oct, are now available in both the Narthex and Parish Hall.



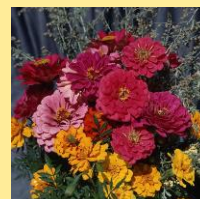
Coffee Hour
