TRUST IN GOD'S PROVIDENCE

In the midst of uncertainty, we have an opportunity to put our faith into practice.

God is sovereign over all things—whether they are as big as the planets or as small as a virus.

He is the Lord, *"our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble"* (Psalm 46:1).

We offer a quiet witness to our faith when we resist panic, knowing that our times and our health have been, and always will be, in the Lord's hands (Psalm 31:15).

USE WISDOM AND BE RESPECTFUL OF OTHERS.

You may wish to refrain from entrance if:

- You have had a fever in the past 2 days
- You have a cough, shortness of breath, or other symptoms typical of Covid-19

- You have any health conditions that would place you at high risk
