DAY OF HARVEST 2018

Mt. Zion's annual "Day of Harvest" will be held on Sunday, November 25 during our morning worship services. The "Day of Harvest" is a special day where Mt. Zion sets aside offerings received for that day to be given to a specific goal. Last year, the "Day of Harvest" offerings received at Mt. Zion totaled 61,653.85! As a reminder, in October 2017, Mt. Zion MBC approved the following building committee recommendations

- the Day of Harvest offerings for 2017 and 2018 be designated for our Building fund.
- we begin transferring \$3,000 a month from the General fund to the Building fund (\$36,000 as of Oct 2018)
- anything over \$30,000 at the end of the month in the General fund would be transferred to the Building fund (\$31,672.29 as of September 2018)
- and a balance of \$500,000 in the Building fund be reached by or before December 31, 2018 before proceeding to the next step of building a new building. (Current Building Fund Balance \$383,017.05)

As the Mt. Zion 2018 "Day of Harvest" approaches, let us exhibit the faith and obedience of the citizens of Jerusalem when informed of the situation of their city by the prophet Nehemiah:

*Nehemiah 2:18—"Then I told them of the hand of my God which was good upon me; as also the king's words that he had spoken unto me. And they said, **Let us rise up and build. So they strengthened their hands for this good work.**"*

With this passage in mind, please give careful prayer and consideration to your "Day of Harvest" contribution, and remember...

"Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver."
