PROACTIVE NOT REACTIVE

I am sure many of you noticed the signs on our doors saying "These doors will be locked during worship time. Please enter through the Sanctuary doors." You might have also noticed a man in the hall by the restrooms during our worship service. The question I am hearing is "What has happened for us to do all of this?" The good news is absolutely nothing has happened, thank God, but we are doing what is necessary to make sure nothing does happen.

It began to bother me that we did not know who was coming in and out of our church during worship. Someone could come in the doors leading to Adult 6-7 and be in our church without us knowing. We also were leaving our nursery exposed to someone that would come in and those in the Sanctuary would never know. And we have many children and adults that go back and forth to our restrooms, and if someone had come in we would never know. All of these things began to trouble me, so I shared with our deacons my concerns, and we are putting a plan

in motion to help protect all of our people. We will lock the doors coming into Adult 6-7 and the doors coming into the breezeway when our worship service begins. The office building and the door to the kitchen are locked so that building is secure. We will lock the south nursery door and leave the north door open for access to the nursery. Someone will be in the hall by the restrooms every Sunday morning during our worship time and will be available to assist you if you have a need. In the future we will make other adjustments so as to make our buildings safe for those that worship. I really do not like doing this but it is necessary in this world in which we are living.
