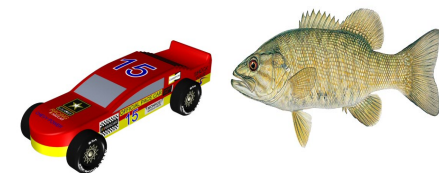

Thank you for being so faithful in helping us with the Snack Pak 4 Kids over these last few years. Your generosity has made the difference in some child's life and the Lord is blessing because of your willingness to give. Last week I received a call from Kayla Parnell who has been heading up our work here and she told me there were changes taking place in how we can help our kids in Pampa and all the kids supplied by Snack Pak. Below is a letter from Snack Pak to explain the changes and why they are happening.

Discontinuation of Peanut Butter and Pop Tart Donations
SPK4K is committed to providing the very best brand name food for the kids we serve. With that in mind, we have opted to discontinue donations of Pop Tarts and peanut butter.

With the recent rash of food recalls, we feel it is of the utmost importance that we are able to track 100% of the food we are distributing. Through our partnerships with Labatt Foods and Affiliated Foods, we are able to track the food used in our Snack Paks via lot number. We are unable to maintain that same standard with donated items. Through our buying cooperative, we are able to stretch our dollars and buy more than our generous donors can at retail. With this in mind, we will continue our commitment to use 100% of donated funds for food unless otherwise designated. Beginning in the Fall of 2016, we are taking our partnership with Kellogg's to the next level and will begin including brand name Kellogg's Nutri-Grain bars in lieu of Pop Tarts. Please know that we still need your partnership to help end weekend hunger in the Texas Panhandle! It is not that we will cease supplying food for our kids but it will be done through donations instead of bringing the designated items to the church. All of the money that is given through our church will be given to our local Snack Pak and the food will be purchased to feed our children in Pampa. The food can be bought so much cheaper through the organization and we will be able to hopefully supply for more children but it is going to take all of us giving for the glory of God.

You can give through the church by either putting a check in your offering envelope and noting it is for Snack Pak and we will get it in that account. Or you can use another envelope and mark it Snack Pak or just bring the money by the church and we will make sure your donation is recorded. The supply of food we have now will be used until it is gone and then we will begin to purchase the items needed. I pray you will continue to be faithful and give to Snack Pak.
