Jesus, in the middle of ministry would "often slip away to the wilderness and pray" in Luke 5:16. Before a major decision Jesus spent time praying all night before calling the 12 Disciples in Luke 6:12. One time Jesus prayed alone and His Disciples were with Him in Luke 9:18.

In my prayer life I never remember having Heaven to open. At other times, in the middle of ministry, I get too busy to pray. When the pressure of a major decision comes, I have never prayed all night. When others are with me, I have a difficult time getting alone to pray. I want to be like Jesus but I must admit that I am just a beginner in prayer. At least if I compare myself to Jesus I am.

In my life there are no days that I can drop because I failed to pray. What about you?

Remember the Holy Spirit came after the church was in unity in prayer.

I remember a story of Suzanna Wesley the mother of John and Charles and 17 other children would sometime during her day raise her apron above her head. It was a signal to her children that she was praying. I wished that I had an apron.
