

When I was 9 years old, during a 24 hour prayer vigil before a Revival meeting, one unconverted girl in the youth group at my home church was killed in a car accident. Those that came to pray were broken before God and began praying for the young people that were lost in our church with intensity like never before. As a result, I was one of more than 20 young people that came to Christ that week. It was a week of meetings that brought Revival. The Revival took place among those that prayed, they repented of sin and returned to the true light of Christ. That light of Christ fell on the meeting at church. The Holy Spirit moved among God's people first; then the lost in the church began to respond to the Holy Spirit.

Tucumcari Baptist Associational Churches connect with Prayer for Revival which began at the TBA meeting in October 2015. Each church is challenged to spend a significant time on a Sunday to Pray for Revival. Some of the churches use morning worship time and some use evening worship time, some may use a separate time on a Sunday. All are encouraged to continue until Revival comes to the community of churches.

Revival begins with the body of Christ. If there is any sin in the body of Christ then the true light of Christ will be hidden. God's people must repent of all sin. Has the Church lost her intensity in prayer?

In a dark world growing darker by sin, what can you do to bring light? Shine the true light.
