Dear Friends,

Jill and I wanted to thank you for the prayers and support you have given us over the last several years as we worked among the Mongols that live outside of Mongolia. We appreciated you welcoming us and providing housing for us while we were in the States. We look forward to continuing our friendships with you all. We are still not sure where we will settle, but we hope to be involved in some sort of ministry. We hope God continues to allow us to be involved with internationals and intentionally making disciples of all nations.

We hope that your churches will continue to pray for the Mongols. Right now, they are still less than 0.5% evangelized. There are about 6,000,000 Mongols that live outside of Mongolia and they are spread

out over an area larger than NM, TX, and OK put together. Currently there are about 20 house churches ranging in number from 5 to 30 members. Those churches need our prayers. God is stirring in the hearts of several of the church leaders about the need to expand dramatically. Please pray with us that God's kingdom would grow among them.

Thanks again for your love and support for us. If we can be of service to your churches in helping engage more with God's work overseas, developing better cross-cultural disciple making in your own town, or learning more effective prayer strategies for the nations, please let us know.
