

Proposed Updates to Reopening Guidelines (June 6th onward):

[Approved by the Diaconate and Council 6/1/2021]

1. All **mask wearing** will become *optional* for attendees and celebrants.
2. The BOH has asked us to **encourage voluntary mask wearing by any unvaccinated persons** while indoors where social distancing is not possible.
3. All **social distancing** requirements will become *optional*.
4. One small **social distancing section will be maintained** in the first six pews to the left of the sanctuary near the piano for those that would like to voluntarily socially distance.
5. All other **floor and pew markings will be removed** in the sanctuary, with the exception of the socially distanced section.
6. The BOH has asked us to **continue to encourage use of hand sanitizer** at our entry points.
7. **Singing will be permitted** in the congregation and by celebrants and encourage those that have not been vaccinated to wear a mask while singing.
8. **Pre-registration** will no longer be required.
9. All **capacity limits** will be lifted.
10. **Dismissal** will return to normal. Dismissal by usher will no longer be needed.
11. The BOH has asked us to **continue our cleaning protocols** following services and events in both the sanctuary and fellowship hall, sanitizing all touch points.
12. We will continue to **ventilate** the sanctuary as much as possible with opening of windows and doors to promote air flow.
13. We will continue to offer printed **bulletins** on the narthex table.
14. For now, we will continue to collect our **offering upon entry** or by mail.
15. For now, we will continue to use the **pre-packaged Communion** elements.
16. For now, we will encourage **contactless greeting** at entry and in the sanctuary.
17. We will continue to offer our **Livestreamed services** on Facebook Live and the web site.
18. Committees will be able to determine which **meeting format** works best for their team, whether that be continuing to use a Zoom meeting format or return to meeting in person.
