What's a Christian to Do?

Well here we are, leaving the summer and approaching the fall. Where has the year gone? It seems as though we no longer live by the clock or calendar. Seemingly, time goes so fast, we now live by seasons of time—winter, spring, summer, and fall.

This also applies to spiritual seasons and times in which we live. One thing is true, we are living in a "season of time", which seems to point to our Biblical time clock and prophetic Word of God.

2021 has proven to be a continuation of turbulent times, beginning with the Global 2020 Pandemic, to the Atrocities of Afghanistan, to those possessed with the destruction of Israel to include the implosion of our current administration compelled to undermine our founding Fathers and Biblical values.

Digital Blackface

Merriam-Webster describes it as "the use by White people of digital depictions of Black or Brown people or skin tones especially for the purpose of self-representation or self-expression."

Entheogen

According to Merriam-Webster, an entheogen is "a psychoactive, hallucinogenic substance or preparation (such as psilocybin or ayahuasca) especially when derived from plants or fungi and used in religious, spiritual, or ritualistic contexts."

Jerry's Surgery Update

I first want to thank all those who prayed, sent get well cards, and called to give encouraging words during my hip surgery at Redlands Community Hospital. This surgery, which should have been 1.5 hours, turned into a 3-hour surgery. And what should have been an over- night stay, turned into a 6 day stay in the hospital.

In addition, I had a few complications with my recent Meniere's disease diagnosis and abdomen issues while in the hospital, which added to my extended recovery process. At the end of the 6-day stay, I could barely stand, let alone walk. Because of this, it was recommended I be transferred to a rehab facility in San Bernardino for further recovery. But I opted to just come home for further physical in-home therapy, and in-home nurse care, which is covered by my insurance.

My recovery time will take a little longer, but I am thankful for the Lord's healing touch, companionship, and help, along with my precious wife Holly who has tirelessly been a tremendous help to me during this time to include returning countless phone calls and text to so many inquirers.

While in the hospital, and now at home, I have reflected on much as I just crossed over my 65th Birthday on September 1st. One main focus has been on the goodness and faithfulness of God in our times of Distress. Websters dictionary defines Distress as "pain or suffering affecting the body, a bodily part, or the mind" or "a painful situation."

However, above the distresses of life, Gods Word is my foundation and reminds me of this fact.... Ps 107:6 says; – *"Then they cried unto the Lord in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses."* KIV
