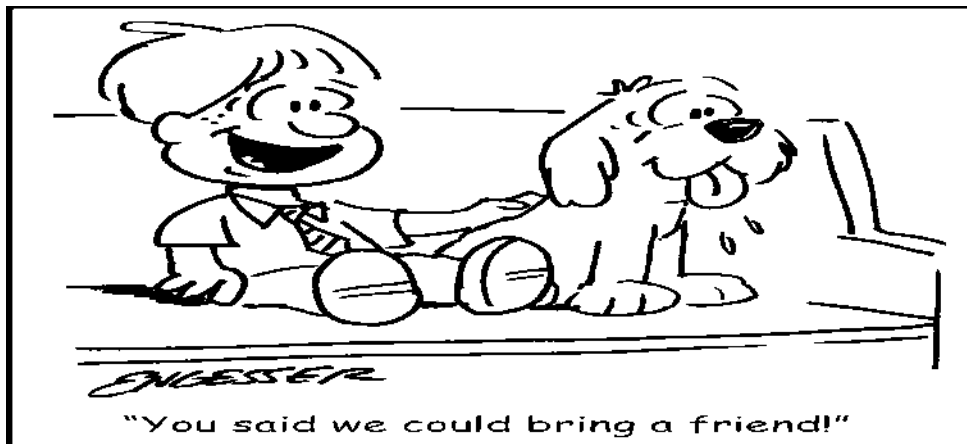

I saw a story on CBS Sunday morning as I was getting ready for church about a host of works that were coming into public domain. For those who may not know about public domain, it is films, music, patents, and other things that are not copy written or their copyright time period runs out. Some things lose their copyright after 50 years, some 75, and others at 100. If the owner does not file the appropriate paperwork, the works become public domain, and anyone can use them. This year works from Charlie Chaplin, Buster Keaton, Harold Lloyd, Agatha Christie, Cecille B. DeMille, and Robert Frost all became public domain for the first time.

As I thought about this, I thought about the gospel. The good news of Jesus' life, ministry, death, and resurrection has been available and free for all to hear and experience for some two thousand years now. Anyone who is willing to hear and respond can become a disciple of Jesus and begin a new life of walking in the Way of Jesus.
