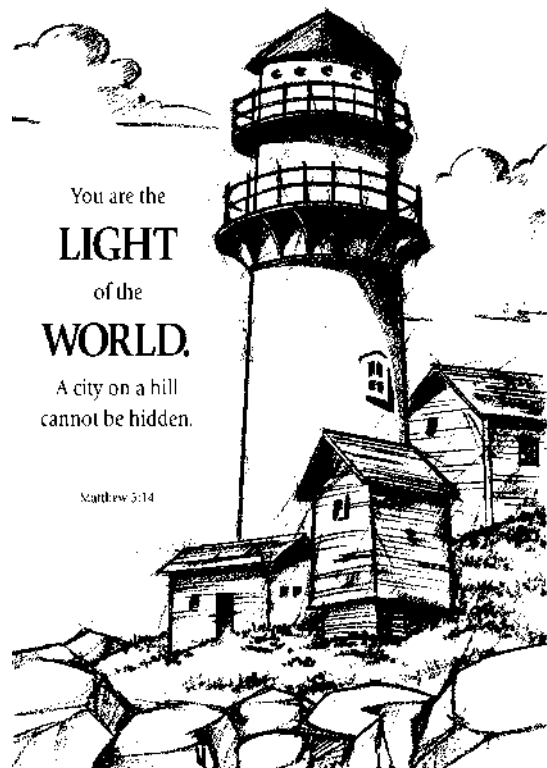

**Musings ~ Pain**

It's funny how we never think about certain things until they hurt. Case in point, most of the time I feel pretty good and I would consider myself in reasonably good shape – not to say I couldn't use a few repairs here and there – but good for the most part. Occasionally, my clumsiness rears its ugly head and I either bump my head (no peripheral vision) or I trip over something. Yesterday, I sort of tripped, rather slipped, when I walked into the bathroom. My wife had just cleaned the floor, something I knew but had forgotten, and it was still wet. I took one step inside and my right foot went out to the side while left foot stayed planted on the carpet just off the linoleum. I didn't fall but I felt it in my knee and my back. It's better this morning and it's still sore, but until I stretched it out a bit this morning, I was feeling it every time I moved.

We tend to want to avoid pain because its well, painful. It hurts and people generally don't like to feel that. But pain, like every other created thing, has a purpose. Pain tells us something is out of place. It is a way of saying that something is not working correctly and needs to be fixed, dealt with, addressed in some manner. And not only do we deal with physical pain but also spiritual and emotional pain. Our hearts ache and our spirits cry out for the same reason our pain receptors light up in our brains: something is wrong and needs to be fixed. In the same way that we need to pay attention to and address physical pain we need to do the same spiritually. That repairing comes out of maintaining a relationship with God through prayer, devotion, and worship.

What part of your spirit is hurting today that needs to be cared for? What can you ask God to help you bear witness to in your spirit in order to be spiritually healthy?
