- *Provide names and addresses to leaders of Women of the ELCA and to all participants of the local unit.

TREASURER:

- *Have copy of constitution
- *Receive and disburse funds of the unit
- *Keep financial records
- *Make regular reports to unit and executive board including a written annual report
- *Interpret and transmit offerings to Women of the ELCA.

KITCHEN KREW DUTIES

WEEKLY---

- * After Sunday morning service wash coffee pots and cups and glasses and put away
- * Take home all dirty towels; wash, and return clean towels to the kitchen
- * Wipe off cabinets and counter tops
- * Check kitchen for leftovers and discard

MONTHLY---

- *Clean refrigerator and sinks
- *Clean oven and range if necessary

- *Straighten up pantry shelves and wipe out shelves and drawers
- *Check supplies and report needs to church office
- *Provide monthly decorations on shelves
- *Check on tablecloths and wash if necessary.

If you are not on the monthly Kitchen Krew but you are on a committee who is using the kitchen, please clean up. All dishes should be washed and properly returned to place. **Please** do not leave left over foods and drinks in the fridge. Table and counters should be wiped clean.
