Music Notes

Among my favorite works appropriate to Holy Week is the setting of the “Seven Last Words of Christ,” by Heinrich Schutz. Schutz was an early German baroque composer, born in 1585, (100 years before Johann Sebastian Bach). While we must comb each of the four Gospels to find these seven utterances of our Savior upon the Cross, the composite text is a moving account of the not-yet-risen Christ’s final moments. As a singer, I find the choral works of Schutz to rival those of Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina from Italy or William Byrd from England. The lines are beautiful and fun to sing.
