the month of August, the service music will come from the South German Baroque repertoire. Composers such as Pachelbel, Kerll, Muffat, and Froberger were composing preludes, fugues, ricercars, toccatas and fantasias. These pieces, however, are typically shorter and less fiery than those by their North German counterparts. In Southern Germany, the influence of Catholic Italy produced a musical calming effect, while the Protestant Reformation, running rampant in North Germany, inspired composers to compose louder and faster works. One notable exception, with a youtube video linked below, is Johann Pachelbel's prelude in d minor. This piece is every bit as thrilling as those from the North German tradition. It opens with an extended pedal solo and explores various musical textures before concluding in the major key.
