William Bolcom is a living composer who was born in Seattle, Washington, in 1938. While his primary performance instrument is the piano, he studied composition with organist Olivier Messiaen in Paris. No doubt his time with Messiaen influenced his decision to compose works for organ. His Gospel Preludes are probably his best-known organ compositions. His setting of "Amazing Grace," in particular, demonstrates his skill as a composer of organ music. Transitioning effortlessly between styles, both ancient and modern, the tune is infused with jazz harmonies and rhythms. A link to a youtube video of the piece follows.
