June 19, 2019, Session Meeting Highlights

- Listened to a presentation from Jeff Studebaker and Connie Huntington who represented a church committee (which includes Linda la Cour and Scott Hookey) that has been working on a Back Sack Program which will provide food for students with food insecurities in the Madison Consolidated Schools. This program will add additional needed back sacks to an existing program in the school corporation. It will provide a week-end sack of food for selected students to take home. The Session approved adopting this Back Sack Program allowing the funding to be received from church members and other funding sources. There will be information available soon for church members to hear more about participating with donations.
- Approved May Session meeting minutes and heard committee reports.
- Approved motion to accept an anonymous donation to replace the office manager and pastor's computers, along with updated software and security protection.
- Approved motion to change the time of worship on September 29th to 9:00 a.m. on Chautauqua weekend.
- Listened to an update from Personnel on the hiring of a primary nursery attendant. Anna Kietzman will become a part-time secondary nursery attendant due to her sometimes conflicting work schedule, and volunteers will be secured as additional secondary nursery helpers.
Session will not be meeting in July.

I've discovered another vocal group that I like very much. Voces8 is a chamber choir made up of eight singers. They are based in England but often do performing tours in other countries. They sing a variety of music, sacred and non-sacred, from different historical periods. Perhaps most notable, beyond their pristine intonation, blend, and innate musicality, is their outreach program. They go into communities, schedule a concert, and then work with local choirs. Then the performance is typically broken into halves. Voces8 sings the first half alone, but, in the second half, the local choirs take the stage and they all perform together.
