### Music Notes

The fire at Notre Dame Cathedral, Paris, has disrupted what has for centuries been a hub of artistic and cultural development. The main organ, while a comparatively recent addition to the space, rebuilt in 1868 by Aristade Cavaille-Coll, remains undisturbed. This organ has been central to the lives of composers Louis Vierne and Alexandre Guilmant, among others. While I am relieved at the survival of the stained glass, the relics, and the statuary, I am particularly grateful that the organ stands to sound again.
