Musical Notes

With Easter almost upon us, I shall begin resurrecting (pun slightly intended) the Widor Toccata for the Easter Morning postlude. The piece is an energetic crowd-pleaser, which I expect many of you would recognize since I've played it every Easter morning since my arrival in 2008. As familiar as this piece is, I'm certain many of you don't know that it is actually the final movement of Widor's Fifth Organ Symphony (link below).

Charles Marie Widor (1844-1937) was professor of composition and organ at the Paris Conservatory and also the organist at St. Sulpice, which boasts one of the largest Cavaille-Coll organs ever built. In addition to his excellent work as teacher, organist, and composer, one of his lasting gifts to the musical community is an edition of J.S. Bach's organ works. Widor cooperated with Albert Schweitzer (1875-1965), noted doctor, philanthropist, and organist, to re-release a collection of Bach's complete (at the time) organ works. The edition they released is the version I still return to when I wish to play the music. I wish you a blessed Lent-remainder and a joyous Eastertide.
