THE CALL TO CONFESSION

L: The invitation to confess begins in 2 Corinthians 4:1-2: "Therefore, since it is by God's mercy that we are engaged in this ministry, we do not lose heart. We have renounced the shameful things that one hides; we refuse to practice cunning or to falsify God's word; but by the open statement of the truth we commend ourselves to the conscience of everyone in the sight of God."

How many of us can say that we are as this passage says? If not, we need to confess and then repent of our sinful ways and change.

I invite you to join me in our Prayer of Confession.

THE PRAYER OF CONFESSION

L: Gracious God, sometimes we are courageous; other times we are filled with fear. Our faith is mixed in with our doubts.

R: One minute we are compassionate; the next minute we are holding a grudge. Humility is nudged aside by our pride.

(A period of silence is observed.)

L: Lord, when we worry, worry steals the peace which passes all understanding. Our hopefulness dissolves into self-pity.

R: We confess that we are broken. We feel powerless to change. We need your mercy. We want to be made whole and new. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.

And he was transfigured before them, ³and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no one on earth could bleach them. ⁴And there appeared to them Elijah with Moses, who were talking with Jesus. ⁵Then Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." ⁶He did not know what to say, for they were terrified. ⁷Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!" ⁶Suddenly when they looked around, they saw no one with them any more, but only Jesus.

⁹As they were coming down the mountain, he ordered them to tell no one about what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead.

O happy ones and holy! Lord, give us grace that we, like them, the meek and lowly, may live eternally.
