and resourcefulness. January 1 will be a day of reflection, anticipation, and transition. As we reflect on this past year many will remember grief and strain. Yet, we can also give thanks. For Joy and me, we give thanks that we made it through 2020 safely and for God providing, and a deep appreciation for simple blessings, such as the sunlight shining through the window and the smiles of friends. Many things we took for granted are now reasons for giving thanks.

As we look forward to 2021, Joy and I will give thanks for a vaccine to help protect her as an RN. We also look forward to a year spent with you, Faith UMC. I anticipate all of us will face a time of transition, and we will have to face our apprehensions about being together and relearn how to reengage. As we take steps to curb the current upsurge, we will eventually resume activities in a new way. It may be many months off, but the day will come.

As I reflect on our life as a congregation I see how we valiantly found new ways of being the church. I am deeply grateful for:

- Staff who constantly adjusted and found new ways to reach people with God's love. They embodied the perseverance of the Holy Spirit.
- Leaders who graciously stepped up putting the purpose of God, the church, and the people above personal preferences. Jesus was a servant leader, and our leaders are following and leading like Jesus.

 Our congregation supported one another, prayed for one another, and participated with a great spirit! Whatever the weather, people attended worship with a "can do" spirit. Many found constructive ways to connect and meet, while continuing ministries such as the "mini-bazaar".

Our spiritual outlook is great for the coming year. We sustained the most challenging year in our God provided for our church and sustained us by His grace. Our current financial outlook for 2021 is mixed. First, the Finance Team thanks the many families who increased their pledges or kept their pledges at the same level. It is essential for our ministry. The Finance Team also is grateful for new families who pledged. However, currently many families who pledged in 2020 have not yet submitted a pledge for 2021. Last year, our commitments totaled \$191,190 and for 2021 they currently total \$146,582. The Finance Committee is proposing a budget with about a 10% reduction in expenses. The remainder of the budget involves building operating expenses, staff salaries, usage. Conference apportionments, and mortgage. The budget will be submitted to Administrative Council in early January. Between now and then, we hope to receive more pledges, so we can continue our current ministries, otherwise further reductions will be made. We have faith in God's provision and you. Thank you for all you do. Together, we embody and enable Faith in the downriver region.
